All the cadets will be personally interview by OC unit. The exact date of raising the NCC Coy at your institution will be intimated to this unit with consultation with the under signed.
5. It is requested that terms and condition for raising NCC & Trg in institution is attached as Appendix and same be reviewed and examined every year.
